About AVKS – Vision & Mission

AZAD VIKALANG KALYAN SAMITI (AVKS) came in to existence to safeguard and welfare of the disadvantaged and differently abled people. It came into existence by a group of differently abled persons for upliftment of differently abled and disadvantaged community. AVKS is a non-profitable, non-political, non-religious voluntary organization, registered under Madhya Pradesh Society Registration Act, 1973 since 2009 serving differently abled people, vulnerable families from most backward areas of Jhabua and Alirajpur districts of Madhya Pradesh.

It is also registered under Section 51 & 52 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protections of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 initiated by Department of Social Welfare, Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

AVKS is striving to build hope among the disadvantaged people through developing opportunity of livelihood sources, awareness of social issue, health services, rehabilitation, promotion of education and vocational courses. We focus to establish a participatory and integrated approach to mainstream disable people towards dignified, self sustained and quality life.

Vision

Envision a society wherein equality and justice are extended to every “differently abled” person and avail life with dignity and immense opportunity for prosperity.

Mission

- To eradicate the stigma of “Vikalang” from the society through community participatory approach and social awareness.
- To create opportunities for differently abled persons to enable them to be self- reliant, confident towards dignified life.



By virtue of its nature of development work for differently abled community, AVKS is known for its participatory approach and operationalizing challenging work in backward tribal areas where the communities are disadvantaged and distant from mainstream development process. These areas often stand low on development indicators and lack basic infrastructure for essentials like healthcare, education or livelihoods.

AVKS vehemently undertakes strategic interventions to raise development indicators in such areas with initiatives in vocational training, health, education, livelihoods, entrepreneurship and women's empowerment.

OBJECTIVES

1. Education, Social and economic development and rehabilitation of Disabled persons.
2. To stop getting disability in society , early detection and treatment.
3. To help the disabled persons to get treatment from the govt. hospitals, get travel concession certificate
4. To identify the able persons from the community of disability and get appropriate job for them and to arrange sports and entertainment programmes for them at every possible places so that they may able to move to their life according to their skill and ability.
5. To start counseling and guidance centre.
6. To start vocational training programmes for this communities, so that they ma able to find out their own livelihood.
7. To get help from the central and state governments for the up-liftment of the community
8. To provide Special Education and special schools for all kinds of the Disabled communities
9. All kinds of welfare activities to be done to get the benefit for the members of disabled community.

Approach/Strategy

- ❖ To organize underserved, deprived, and disadvantaged people and unite them.
- ❖ Build up the capacity of CBOs to establish a self-sustaining system of CBOs for social and economic changes.
- ❖ Implement community development programs, linkage with government schemes and Corporate Social Responsibility towards better quality of life of target groups.
- ❖ Promote local self-governance for sustainability of the program's impact.

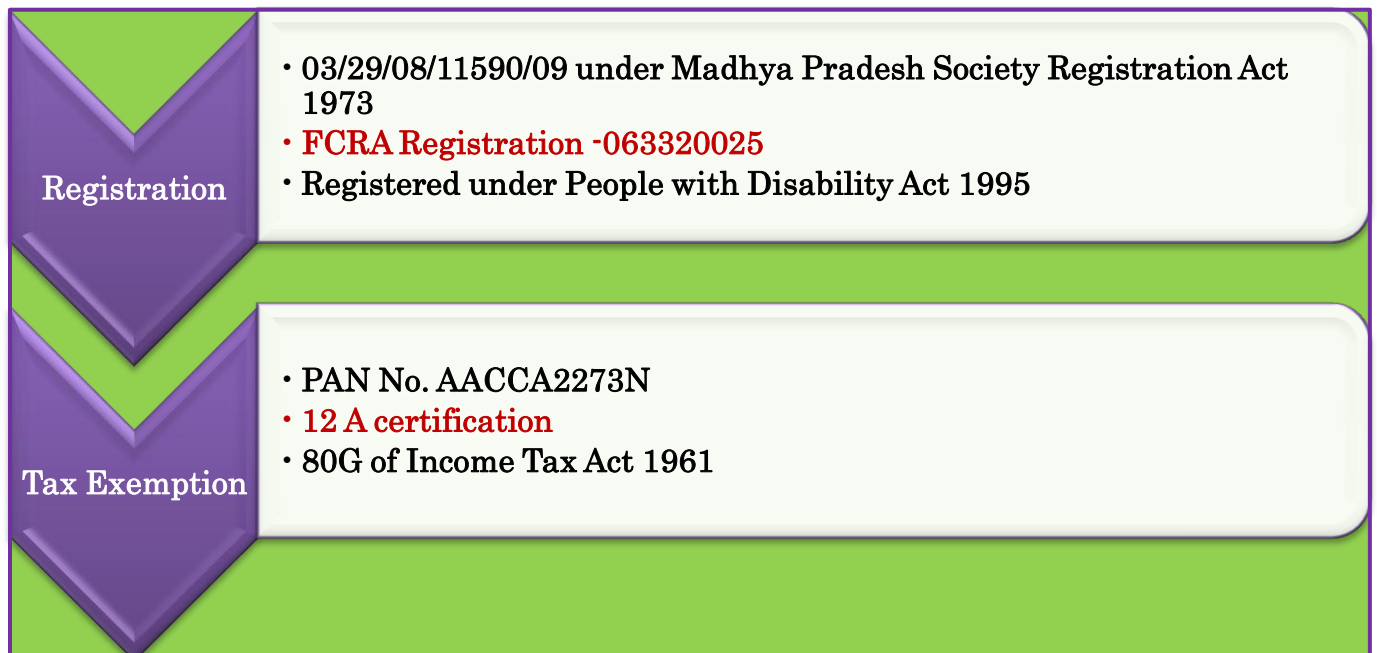

Organizational Structure

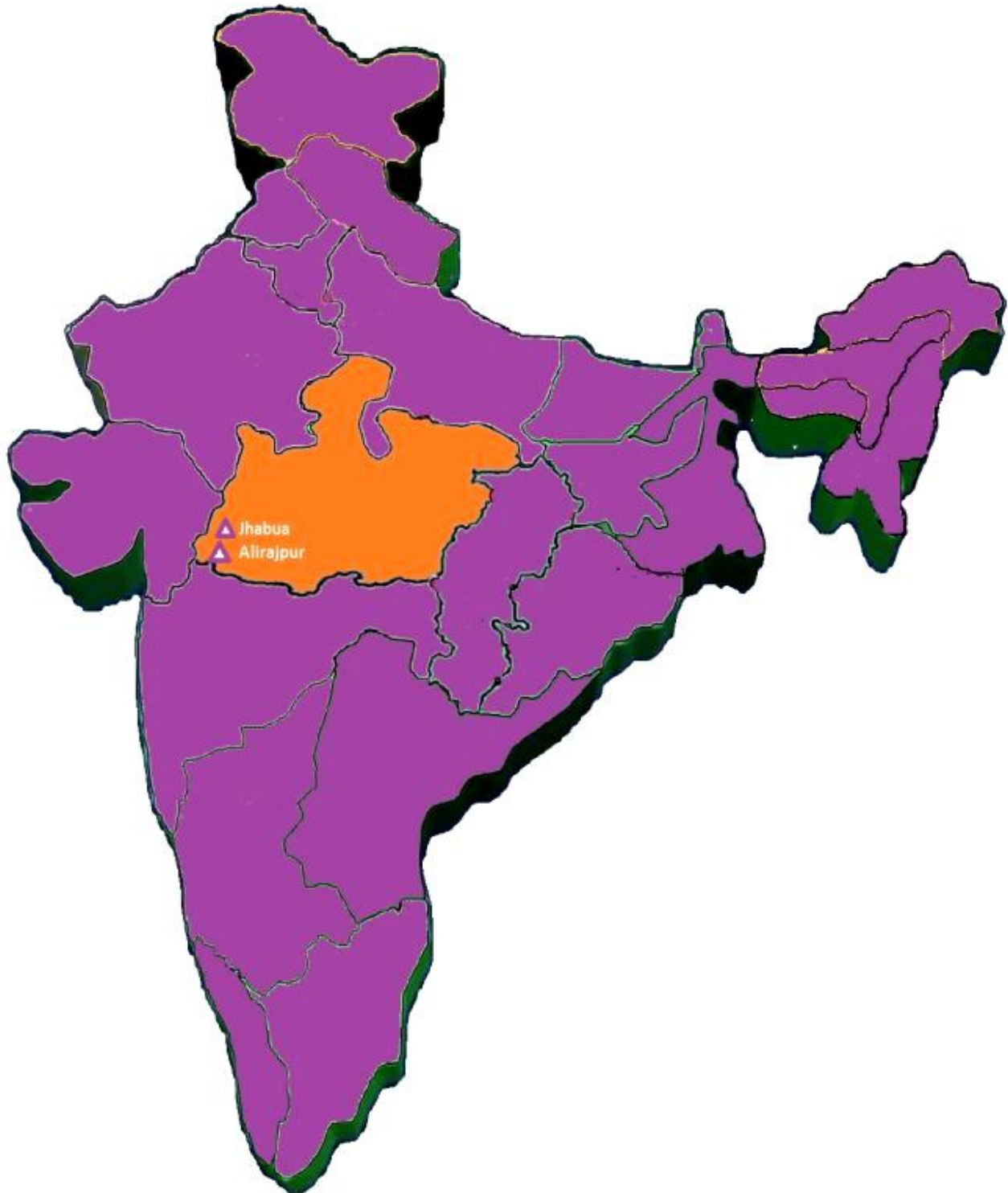

ABOUT THE ORGANIZATION

AZAD VIKALANG KALYAN SAMITI is established in the year 2009 is a registered non-profit making society having a secular constitution. It is situated at Indore. It is a Voluntary Organization engaged in health and developmental activities. Right from its inception in the year 2009, it is engaged in the field of bringing the disabled persons to the main stream of life through vocational training programmes like making of envelopes, stitching etc. It also does liaison with government, NGOs and other agencies.

OFFICE AND INFRASTRUCTURE

AZAD VIKALANG KALYAN SAMITI has an office at Meghnagar Jhabua(MP), having minimum amenities to run the office in a systematic manner.

MANAGEMENT

AZAD VIKALANG KALYAN SAMITI is governed by 7 members team elected, known as Governing Board of the Society. The Governing Board of AZAD VIKALANG KALYAN SAMITI meets from time to time, to review, steer the activities and to take policy decisions, in order to achieve the desired goal of the organization.

PROGRAMMES

WOMEN'S HEALTH

In Indian society, which is known for its varied culture and customs, woman ,very easily, becomes the target of certain customs, which directly or indirectly infringe her basic human rights. Existing social structure, non- availability of opportunities, high incidence of violence , and exploitation at various levels etc. all leave women with very poor health and other development indicators.



Azad Vikalang Kalyan Samiti always stand to change the attitude of the society regarding the customs and traditions related to the women. We have conducted various awareness programmes and other kind of activities to make aware the public about the present scenario and the need for changes of attitude in the mind of people and society. We organized heath camps for the public especially for the women. As a result a large number of women got proper treatment and support for their life.



VOCATIONAL TRAININGS:



Azad Vikalang Kalyan Samiti always looks for the self sustainability of every one, especially the backward community. Therefore, we have organized different vocational trainings programmes for the women and unemployed persons of Jhabua and Alirajpur districts. Mainly the people of these districts interested in stitching and envelope making and “dona pathha” making trainings. Envelope and “dona Pathha” making programme is very simple and even the disabled people can also easily attain this knowledge and able to make additional

income for their livelihood. Many people taken the benefit of these programmes which we count as our outstanding achievement. We organized these programmes without taking any fee from the participants. But general public and well wishers or some NGOs held us in the form of financial support to make our effort successful. Her we acknowledge their kind heart and support.

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMES:

School Health programme for the drop out students is one of the important activity of Azad Vikalang Kalyan Samiti. As previous years this year also we organized many programmes to motivate the drop out students to resume their school education in regular basis.



ANTI-TOBACCO & DRUGS PROGRAMME:

World No Tobacco Day campaign was organized by Azad Vikalang Kalyan Samiti, Meghnagar. The main objectives of the campaign were : to sensitize the youths, local authorities, NGOs, media and masses about the dangers of Tobacco use, to create general awareness among the



public on the hazards of Tobacco. We also organized rallies and street plays at Meghnagar and Alirajpur .

Azada Vikalang Kalyan Samiti is a partner NGO of MP Voluntary Health Association, Indore in the process of making public places smoke free supported by the UNION and Bloomberg Global Initiatives. Under this project we conducted many programmes like



liaison and advocacy with other NGOs and local government, putting of signages at various public places, organized Jan samwad or public hearings, awareness programmes for the masses. With the help of this project we could able to reach to the unreached and create a movement in the society regarding the danger situation of using the tobacco products. It was a very successful programme and we acknowledge the support from MP Voluntary Health Association, Indore.



PHYSICALLY CHALANGED:

Azad Vikalang Kalyan Samiti came in to existence to safe guard or do the welfare of the disabled community. It is formed by the disabled persons , for the disabled persons and to be with the disabled community. Therefore its our main duty to work for the physically challenged group. This year also we did a lot of programmes for the upliftment of this particular community.

A) We celebrated the World disability day. During this day rallies were organized, awreness and advocacy programme were also conducted to make people aware that the physically challenged persons are able to do something for the society if they have the will and support from the general public. As usual the response was very motivational.

B) “PARICHAYA SAMMELAN”



Every year we conducted “parichay Sammelan” of youths from the physically challenged group. Family members or responsible persons are not taking enough interest to lead these persons to a normal family life even they are not think of it. Since Azada Vikalang Kalyan Samiti is formed for the welfare of thses persons, we have taken this responsibility for certain extend. Through this parichay sammelan many pairs came together to lead a family life. This was a good

oppportunity for them to find right person for their life.

C) *Kanyadan & Vivah Protsahan:*

In collaboration with Mukhyamantri Kanyadan yojna, we have organized community marriages for the disabled persons in Jhabua and Alirajpur districts. This was a wounderful programme for those who are facing the financial crisis to manage their marriage and the afterwards expenses. Many of the poor family members got the benefit of this programme and able to go ahead with their normal married life with out any debt or others financial problems. Azad Vikalang Kalyan Samiti acknowledge here all



the well wishers especially the state government's 'Mukhya Mantri Kanyadan Yojna'.

OTHER PROGRAMMES:

This year also we observed the various health days as usual as per of advocacy and awareness among the masses. World AIDS day is observed every year across the world on the 1st December to generate mass awareness and keep the hopes alive. Azad Vikalang Kalyan Samiti is always benn on forefront in initiating and promoting advocacy , awareness and decision making to stop AIDS.

Health Environment Day is also observed by the Association to create awareness among the public regarding the importance of nature in human life.



We also organized some programs on children's day to motivate the young generation .

As every year, we have done liaison with other NGOs and Government Officers and offices for financial assistance and support.

Sustainable Livelihood

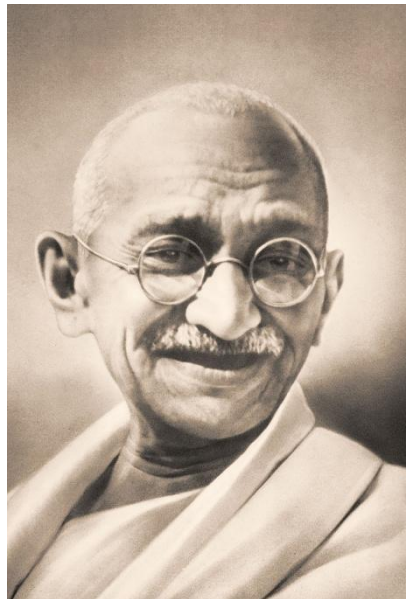

With the support of FVTRS, organization has been initiated job oriented skill enhancement program for youth of backward area. This project is helping to transform lives of unemployed youth (school dropout & person with disability) and also building job opportunity to improve their economic status. This project would generate employment for 120 youth after completing skill enhancement training;
